Despereaux was released in November 2008 to fairly good reviews. It tells the story of a mouse who doesn't fit in with all the other mice, but is determined to become a hero anyway. The film has an all-star cast including Matthew Broderick, Ciaran Hinds, William H Macy and Dustin Hoffman. "Despereaux" is rated "PG". This rating means that it may be unsuitable for viewers under the age of 12.
